


TEMPLATE/GUIDE

The template provided is to be used as a guide for cutting. Due to the nominal dimensions and installation preference, some customization will be required. In some instances a template may not be included. If this is the case, the countertop fabricator will make a custom template basedupon the sink itself.


REPLACEMENT

If replacing a pre-existing hole, make sure that the model you have chosen is larger than the existing hole. This will allow for any adjustments that might be needed for the installation process.



For proper adhesion, please make sure that the rim is clean, dry and dust free.

- 2. Cut out center of template.
- 3. Place template on countertop and trace the cut-out line

WHAT'S NOT INCLUDED


Silicone Sealant/Adhesive

Step: 1

1. Drill a pilot hole in the counter top.



Using the recommended tool for the counter material, cut along the inside of the traced line



Step: 2

INSTALLATION

- Insert the faucet if there are faucet holes in the sink.
- 2. Fit the sink into the cut out to ensure it fits.
- 3. Make any adjustments if necessary.



Step: 3

INSTALLATION- Cont'd.

- Apply sealant to the outer edge where sink meets counter top. Fill andy voids.
- 2. Wipe away any excess sealant.
- 3. Allow to dry /cure.



Install faucet, drain connections, and plumbing as recommended by the manufacturers specifications.
